Developing local skills to prevent, resolve, and transform violent conflict.

We design and implement multi-year programs that amplify local voices, transform conflict, and build skills for a peaceful society.

Our widely diverse projects are developed in response to invitations from in-country partners. In the past 10 years, we have worked across 15 countries on four continents, and have:

- ▶ Established mediation centers and learning partnerships
- ▶ Reconciled ethnic communities and violent conflicts
- ▶ Supported leadership development for women political aspirants
- ▶ Advocated for mediation in climate change disputes
- ▶ Built systems for displaced persons returning home
- ▶ Established restorative justice systems integrating trauma-informed principles
- ▶ Convened dialogues on immigration conflicts
- ▶ Reintegrated former combatants safely into communities

Together, we develop the critical capacities needed to address conflicts, whether within institutions or at the grassroots level.
